






SAMPLE DAILY SCHEDULE

SAFETY, OUR #1 PRIORITY

Our staff members are First Aid & CPR certified, they have many years of experience skiing/snowboarding and working with children, they are concerned about the safety, well-being and joy of all our campers. They are multicultural, multilingual, outgoing, fun, easy-going and well trained to ensure a safe and professional care for your child.

The camp is divided in small counsellor groups with a supervision ratio of 1 counsellor for every 6 campers or less.



CAMP ORGANIZATION

The camp is divided in small counsellor groups by skill level:

Beginner: Never skied before, lessons are mandatory.

Intermediate: Comfortable on blue runs.


Advance: Comfortable on black runs.





Our basecamp for our winter camp is a neat, clean and centrally located apartment style building where our campers and staff live during the camp.

- Each apartment takes up to 6 people.
- Campers sleep in double occupancy bedrooms with a private bathroom.
- Girls sleep in separate apartments from boys.
- Camp staff live in separate apartments from campers and patrols the residence 24/7 to supervise and assist campers.
- A camp nurse is available 24/7 to take care of all health related matters.



Food is one of the most important and most difficult aspects of camp. We welcome campers from many different countries, and different palates, so cooking at camp is not an easy task.

We purchase all food locally to cook with the freshest possible ingredients and make sure our meals are well balanced with all the nutrients our campers need to reach high levels of energy so they can stay healthy and enjoy all camp activities to the fullest.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Skis, boots, poles and helmet. OR snowboard, boots and helmet.
- Jacket and pants (waterproof & insulated materials).
- Base layer and mid-layer (merino wool and insulated materials for optimal warmth and breathability).
- Snow gloves/mittens.
- Winter hat and face mask or neck warmer.
- Goggles.
- Socks (merino wool).
- Day pack, big enough to fit gear, water and snacks for the day.
- Comfortable clothes, for after skiing/snowboarding.
- Water bottle.
- Bathing suit & towel, for shower, hot tub and pool.
- Winter boots and sandals.
- Personal hygiene items (tooth brush/paste, soap, shampoo, etc).

Note: For those parents with little or no experience with winter sports, it is extremely important for the kids to be warm and conformable so they can have a fun and positive experience. Please, do not send your kids underdressed for camp.

NAME TAGS

Please make sure your children's gear and clothes have name tags on them. It's easier to recognize their belongings and it helps to reduce the risk of loosing them.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Do not bring any electronics to camp please! We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Cellphones to call home are ok but they will be kept in the camp office.

CAMP FEE INCLUDES:

- 4 days of skiing/snowboarding.
- 4 nights in our camp residence (double room occupancy).

- 24/7 supervision by our staff, on and off the mountain.

- Check-out: Friday March 31st at 3 pm, lunch included.

ADMIN FEES

Online registration fee - \$3
Credit card payments - 3% fee.
International wire transfers - \$25 fee.

5% off the 2nd sibling.
10% off the 3rd or more sibling.
Discount applies to camp fee only, not add-ons.

TRANSPORTATION (roundtrip)

From Calgary - \$120

From Edmonton - \$150

To / From YYC Calgary airport. This service must be requested and a special form must be submitted.

CANCELLATION INSURANCE

\$100 per camper

Camp fees are non-refundable. If cancellation insurance is purchased and the camp is canceled before the start of camp, we will issue a full refund minus the cancellation insurance fee. Once the camp has started no refunds are issued whatsoever.

CAMP CHECK-IN

1. Arrivals are on Monday March 27th at 3pm at our camp residence located at:

316 Marten St. Banff, AB. T1L 1E6.

Campers arriving at the YYC airport please request transportation by submitting an Airport Transportation Request Form. No arrivals on Saturday or Monday please. Each arrival is handled individually.

2. Security deposit. We require a \$100 security deposit (in cash) which will be refunded to you at the end of your stay if no damage has been done to the premises. In case of small damage or special cleaning needed, the camp will keep the deposit and may contact the parents if a larger amount is needed.

3. Collection of important belongings. For everyone's peace of mind, we collect passports, money, medicine and any other important items to place them in the camp's office. Campers will have access to their belongings at any time during camp and all belongings will be returned at the check-out.

4. Medication. No campers are allowed to have any kind of medication in their rooms. Parents must submit medication and the instructions for administration to our senior staff when checking in at camp and our staff will take care of administering such medication to your children as indicated.



CAMP CHECK-OUT

1. Departures are on Friday March 31st at 3pm, lunch included.

Note: Campers departing from the YVR airport please request transportation by submitting an Airport Transportation Request Form. No departures on Thursday or Saturday please. Each departure is handled individually.

2. Returns. All security deposits, personal items, money and medication will be returned to the campers when checking out.
