## **SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY!**

All of our camp activities and excursions are carefully planned to prevent accidents and maximize the safety of all our campers and staff. Campers learn basic skills to survive in the backcountry, risk assessment and risk management, incident prevention and how to deal with wildlife encounters and many more skills to keep them safe in all their future adventures.

Our **STAFF** is carefully selected and trained to make sure our campers are safe and enjoy every activity at camp while making friendships that will last a lifetime. Most of our staff ages 20-35 y/o. They are multicultural, multilingual, outgoing and fun. They are trained with First Aid & CPR and cleared a criminal background check.

We have a minimum ratio of 1 counsellor for every 10 campers, lifeguards, senior staff, and a full time nurse to complement the supervision, health care and safety of all our campers.

The Canadian Rockids camp uses a few different accommodation settings throughout the duration of the camp. Whether we stay in a cabin or a campground, our campers will always have a proper, clean and comfortable place to clean up and rest to recharge batteries for the next adventure.

- Campers sleep in shared bedrooms/tents with private bathroom.
- Girls always sleep separate from boys in different rooms/ tents and different bathrooms.
- Camp staff sleeps on site in different bedrooms/tents than the campers but always patrolling the area to supervise and assist campers.
- Camp counsellors and the camp nurse are available 24/7 to take care of the campers needs including health related matters.



Food is one of the most important and challenging aspects of camp. We welcome campers from many different countries, and different palates, so cooking at camp is a work of art.

We purchase all food locally to cook with the freshest possible ingredients and make sure our meals are well balanced with all the nutrients our campers need to reach high levels of energy so they can stay healthy and enjoy all camp activities to the fullest.

**AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION - \$125 each way.**

We offer transportation to/from the YYC Calgary International airport. You can request this service when registering for camp. (Please submit the Airport Transportation Request Form).

**CANCELLATION INSURANCE - \$100**

Camp fees are non-refundable. If cancellation insurance is purchased and the camp is cancelled before the start of camp, we will issue a full refund minus the cancellation insurance fee. Once the camp has started there are no refunds.

**CAMP VIDEO - \$99**

## WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

This is the checklist of suggested items for campers to bring to camp:

- Travel backpack (no suitcases please).
- Comfortable athletic and casual clothing for one week.
- Hiking shoes, running shoes, and sandals.
- Rain coat and a light down-filled jacket.
- Hat and sunscreen to protect from the sun.
- Water bottle or Camelbak.
- Bathing suit and towel.
- Bug spray.
- Sleeping bag, insulated camping mattress and a pillow.
- Sweat pants and a hoodie.
- Warm hat and mittens.
- Merino wool base layers.
- Personal hygiene items (tooth brush/paste, soap, shampoo, etc).
- A headlamp and batteries (no electricity at camp).
- Musical instruments such as guitar, flute, harmonica, etc (optional).

### Important notes:

1. Campers must wear the camp t-shirt during most activities and excursions at camp. They will get one free t-shirt the first day of camp and you can purchase extras if needed.
2. Please put name tags on your children's gear and clothes so it's easier to recognize their belongings, and it helps to reduce the risk of losing them.



## ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

1. Computers, tablets and video games are prohibited at camp. Electronic readers, music players and photo cameras are allowed in certain times of the day. Cellphones are allowed only to call home.
2. All electronic devices will be collected from the campers and stored in the camp's office for safety. Campers will have access to their electronics upon authorization of the staff. All electronics are returned to the camper at the end of the camp session.
3. Canadian Rockkids is not responsible for loss nor for damage of electronic devices unless mishandled by our staff. Each camper is responsible of their own electronics. Please avoid bringing electronics to camp. Camp is the best place to disconnect from the digital world and connect with real people and friendships.

## CAMP CHECK-IN

**1. Arrival.** Make sure all camp fees are paid. Arrivals must be on Sunday July 10th at 3 pm at the following address:  
801 Hidden Ridge Way, Banff, AB. T1L 1B3.

**Note:** If you need airport transportation please request it in the registration form and submit a completed Airport Transportation Request Form. If the camper arrives before 3 pm, make sure your child has some money to buy food. Dinner is at 5 pm. No arrivals on Saturdays or Mondays please.

**2. Security deposit.** We require a \$100 security deposit (in cash) which will be refunded to you at the end of your stay if no damage has been done to the premises. In case of small damage or special cleaning needed, the camp will keep the deposit and may contact the parents if a larger amount is needed.

**3. Collection of important belongings.** For everyone's peace of mind, we collect passports, money, medicine and any other important items to place them in the camp's safety box. Campers will have access to their belongings at any time during camp and all belongings will be returned at check-out.

**4. Medication.** We keep all types of medication out of the reach of campers. No campers are allowed to have any kind of medication on them. Parent's must submit medication and the instructions for administration to our senior staff when checking in at camp and our staff will take care of administering such medication to your children as indicated.



## CAMP CHECK-OUT

**1. Departure.** Friday 22nd at 10 am. Airport transfers will be addressed individually depending on traveling times.

**Note:** If you need airport transportation please request it in the registration form and submit a completed Airport Transportation Request Form. If the plane departs late in the afternoon/evening make sure your children has some money to buy lunch and/or dinner.

**2. Returns.** Security deposits, personal items, medication and/or money kept in the safe will all be returned at check-out.

## COMMUNICATING WITH CAMPERS

### Campers contacting their parents.

Campers can contact their parents anytime during their free time either by phone or email using their own phone or the camp's phone/computer.

### Parents contacting their children.

## LAUNDRY POLICY

The camp fee includes one load of laundry (washer, dryer and detergent) for the camp session. Laundry day is on Sunday, half way through the camp session. Make sure your child has enough clean clothing to spend the week. Campers won't have access to the laundry room any other day. Counsellors help campers to do their laundry, do not panic!
