

INTRODUCTION & CAMP DATES

Welcome to Camp Ecolart, Canada's coolest Overnight Camp located in Montreal, QC. where your children will have their best summer of their lives and meet new friends from all over the world!

Our summer Overnight Camp is an all-inclusive 2-week program for **boys and girls 8 to 17 years old**. You may want to register for both sessions if you wish.

Session 1: July 9 - 22, 2023.

Session 2: July 23 - Aug 5, 2023.



SAFETY & STAFF

Safety is our #1 priority! All of our camp activities and excursions are carefully planned to prevent accidents and maximize the safety of all our campers and staff. We have minimum 1 counsellor for every 10 campers, plus CITs (Counsellors In Training), senior staff, camp security and a full time In-residence nurse to complement the supervision, health care and safety of all our campers.

Our staff members are carefully selected and trained to make sure our campers are safe and enjoy every activity at camp while making friendships that will last a lifetime. Most of our staff ages range from 18 to 35 y/o, they are multicultural, multilingual, outgoing and fun, All of them are trained with First Aid & CPR and cleared a criminal background check.

CAMP ORGANIZATION

Campers are divided in age groups for all camp activities; Juniors 8-12, Teens 13-15 and CITs 16-17. We divided campers in 4 different houses (below images) to compete in different organized camp games and activities to accumulate points and win the ECOLART CUP.





TRADITIONAL CAMP

Our Traditional Camp follows the schedule above and includes the following camp activities/games:

Mornings (3 hrs): biking, soccer, floor hockey, football, tennis, basketball, cooking, fishing, arts & crafts, kayaking, stand up paddle boarding, beach volleyball, archery, and more.

Afternoons (3 hrs): capture the flag, dodgeball, volley pong, loopy balls, tug o' war, Ecolart olympics, canoeing, talent show, swimming, and more.



ESL CAMP

(English as a Second Language)

Our ESL camp follows the same schedule as our Traditional Camp program except that campers take 3 hrs of ESL classes (basic or Intermediate level only) in the morning instead of their regular camp activities.

ESL classes focus on developing reading, writing, conversation and comprehension skills of the language with a maximum class size of 15 campers per teacher.



NOTE: All our camp activities and games are subject to weather conditions and may vary from week to week to ensure safety of the campers and staff and to maximize a positive and fun experience at camp.

Our renovated camp residence offers a comfortable, clean and safe accommodation for all our campers. Girls sleep in different floor than boys with same gender counsellors. Staff sleeps in adjacent apartments to the campers within the same floor to supervise them 24/7. Each apartment takes up to 4 campers and has 2 double bedrooms, living room, kitchenette and a full bathroom.





Food is one of the most important and most difficult aspects of camp. We welcome campers from over 35 different countries, meaning different type of food and different taste. Our campers must be ready to experience a multicultural culinary experience and be open to try new things.

We work hard to make a menu that pleases most of our campers and we offer dishes that are closer to an international menu that we modify each year to make it better and better. Our menu is pre-approved by a dietician to make sure is well balanced with all the nutrients our campers need to reach high levels of energy so they can stay healthy and enjoy camp to the fullest.


CAMP FEES INCLUDE:

- 24/7 supervision by our staff.
- Accommodation in our camp residence.
- 3 meals and 1 snack per day.
- Daily camp activities and games & excursions.
- 1 laundry load.
- 1 free camp t-shirt.
- Check-in: Sundays 3pm, dinner included.
- Check-out: Saturdays 10am, breakfast included.

Note: credit card payment fee of 3% and International wire transfer fee of \$20 applies.

Camp fees are tax deductible as childcare expenses for Canadians. Request your tax slip at the end of the year.

Family discount 5% off the 2nd camper, and 10% off the 3rd or more campers. Discount applies for the camp fee of siblings only, not friends or cousins. Discount does not apply for all additional services.



AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION - \$50 each way

We offer transportation from and to the YUL airport or the Dorval train station. Please submit an Airport Transportation Request Form when registering for camp if you require this service. All flights must arrive or depart on Sunday. If the flight arrives before the check-in time or leaves after the check-out time, please make sure the children have some money to cover the cost of meals and other expenses.

Important: Before flying, please make sure the camper has all immigration documents in order and all airline fees paid, such as unaccompanied minor fee and luggage fee. Camp Ecolart staff is not responsible for fixing any issues with the airline or


Get all the camp photos in digital HD resolution in a USB. Every week the photos change so you can buy as many weeks as you wish.

CAMP T-SHIRT - \$25 each

Campers get one free t-shirt when they check-in at camp. They must wear it from Monday to Friday from 9 am to 4pm and during excursions, the rest of the time they can use their regular clothes. Campers can buy extra t-shirts anytime.

CANCELLATION INSURANCE - \$100/session

Camp fees are non-refundable. If cancellation insurance is purchased and the camp is canceled before the start of camp, we will issue a full refund minus the cancellation insurance fee. Once the camp has started no refunds are issued whatsoever.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Comfortable athletic / casual clothing & shoes for 1 week.
- Sandals.
- Rain coat.
- Sweater / hoodie.
- Hat.
- Water bottle.
- Bathing suit.
- Towel.
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent lotion.
- Personal hygiene (tooth brush/paste, soap, shampoo, etc).
- A headlamp with batteries.
- Funky / fun items for disco nights and talent shows.
- Musical instruments (optional).
- Skateboard, roller blades, etc...(optional).
- Lots of energy and a great spirit to learn, make new friends, and have the best summer of your life!

Important notes:

1. Campers must wear the camp t-shirt every day. They will get one t-shirt the first day of camp and you can purchase extras if needed.
2. Please put name tags on your children's gear and clothes, it's easier to recognize their belongings and it helps to reduce the risk of losing them.
3. The camp provides one pillow and pillow case, bed linens and a blanket, no need to bring sleeping bags. You may want to bring extra pillows if you want.



ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

1. Computers, tablets and video games are prohibited at camp. Electronic readers, music players and photo cameras are allowed during free time or excursions. Cellphones are allowed only to call home during designated times.
2. All electronic devices will be taken away from the campers when they check-in at camp and they will be stored in the camp's office. Campers will have access to their electronics during free time or excursions upon authorization of the staff.
3. If a campers is found using electronics out of the designated times or areas, they will be confiscated for the duration of camp and the camper will get a disciplinary warning. Electronics are returned to the camper at the end of the camp session.
4. Camp Ecolart is not responsible neither for loss nor for damage of electronic devices unless mishandled by our staff. Each camper is responsible of their own electronics. Please avoid bringing electronics as much as possible, camp is the best place to disconnect from the digital world and connect with real people and friendships.

CAMP CHECK-IN

1. Arrival. Before arriving, make sure all camp fees are paid off, campers with a balance won't be accepted at camp. Arrivals must be on Sundays at 3 pm at the address below:

Note: If your child needs transportation from the airport or train station, you must request it in the registration form and submit a completed Airport Transportation Request Form by email at least 2 weeks before the arrival date. If the camper arrives before 3 pm, make sure your child has some money to buy breakfast/lunch, they won't have access to their room until 3pm and dinner at 5 pm. No arrivals on Saturdays or Mondays please.

2. Security deposit. We require a \$50 security deposit (in cash) which will be refunded to you at the end of your stay if no damage has been done to the premises. In case of small damage or special cleaning needed, the camp will keep the deposit and may contact the parents if a larger repair needs to be done.

3. Collection of important belongings. For everyone's peace of mind, we collect passports, money, medicine and any other important items to place them in the camp's safety box. Campers will have access to their belongings at any time during camp and all belongings will be returned at the check-out.

4. Medication. By law, we must keep any sort of medication out of the reach of children. No campers are allowed to have any kind of medication in their rooms. Parent's must submit medication and the instructions for administration to our senior staff when checking in at camp and our staff will take care of administering such medication to your children as indicated.



CAMP CHECK-OUT

1. Departures. All departures are on Saturdays at 10 am. Airport/Train station requests will be addressed individually depending on the traveling times.

Note: If the camper needs to be dropped-off at the airport or train station, you must submit a completed Airport Transportation request form by email at least 2 weeks before the departure date. If the plane departs late on Saturday after 10 am, make sure your children has some money to buy lunch and/or dinner.

2. Returns. Security deposit and all personal items and money kept in the safe will be all returned when checking out.

COMMUNICATING WITH CAMPERS

- Children contacting their parents: campers can contact their parents anytime during their free time either by phone or email using their pwn phone or the camp's phone/computer.
- Parents contacting their children: For non-emergencies please send a letter to your children by email to info@ecolart.ca our staff will print the letter and hand it to your children personally, this exercise helps us keep the camp line available for emergency situations, it also helps your children integrate better and faster at camp, plus it's actually really fun to receive a letter from family far away. You may also request a phone call from your child by email. For emergencies please call or email us. The camp line is open 24/7, however avoid calls after 10 pm and before 8 am our staff also needs a good rest.



LAUNDRY POLICY

Camp fees include one load of laundry (washer, dryer and detergent) for the 2-week session.

Laundry days are on Sundays only. Make sure your children has enough clean clothing to spend the week. Campers are allowed to use the laundry during their free time if needed, a \$5 fee per load applies. Counsellors help their campers to do their laundry, do not panic!
