SAFETY & STAFF

Safety is our #1 priority! All of our camp activities and excursions are carefully planned to prevent accidents and maximize the safety of all our campers and staff. We have minimum 1 counsellor for every 10 campers, plus CITs (Counsellors In Training), senior staff, camp security and a full time In-residence nurse to complement the supervision, health care and safety of all our campers.

Our staff members are carefully selected and trained to make sure our campers are safe and enjoy every activity at camp while making friendships that will last a lifetime. Most of our staff ages 20-40 y/o, they are multicultural, multilingual, outgoing and fun, They are trained with First Aid & CPR and cleared a criminal background check.





SAMPLE DAILY SCHEDULE

- 7:30 - Wake up and get ready for the day.
- 8:00 - Breakfast.
- 9:00 - Different activities every day, such as mountain biking, hiking, kayaking, canoeing, paddle boarding, zip lining, and more.
- 12:00 - Lunch break.
- 13:00 - Different games/sports every day, such as capture the flag, tug o'war, dodgeball, ultimate frisbee, swimming and more.
- 16:00 - Relaxing time, showering, cleaning rooms.
- 17:00 - Dinner.
- 18:00 - Evening games, bonfire and s'mores, tent camping, village walks and more.
- 21:00 - Snacks.
- 21:30 - Lights out.



CAMP ORGANIZATION

The camp is divided by ages groups:

Juniors: ages 10 to 12 / **Teens:** ages 13 to 15 / **CIT's:** ages 16 to 17

Boys and girls are mixed up in each group which are subdivided in 4 different houses to compete in different camp games and activities and win Tsuly's Cup at the end of the week.

ACCOMMODATION

Camp Ecolart Whistler residence is a neat, clean and centrally located basecamp for all our camp adventures.

- Campers sleep in double occupancy bedrooms with private bathroom.
- Girls sleep separate from boys in different rooms.
- Camp staff patrols the residence 24/7 to supervise and assist campers.
- A camp nurse is available 24/7 to take care of all health related matters.

CAMP FEE INCLUDES:

TAX CREDIT

Camp fees are tax deductible as childcare expenses for Canadians. Request your tax slip at the end of the year.

ADMIN FEES - Credit card payments - 3% fee. / International wire transfers - \$25 fee.



AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION - \$125 each way

Transportation from and to the Vancouver YVR airport. Please see the Airport Transportation Request Form to review terms and conditions.

CANCELLATION INSURANCE - \$100 per week

Camp fees are non-refundable. If cancellation insurance is purchased and the camp is canceled before the start of camp, we will issue a full refund minus the cancellation insurance fee. Once the camp has started no refunds are issued whatsoever.

CAMP CHECK-IN


1. **Arrival.** Arrivals must be on Sundays at 4 pm at the camp residence address: *1080 Legacy Way, Whistler, BC. V8E 0K3.*

Note: Airport transfers will be addressed individually depending on traveling times. No arrivals on Saturdays or Mondays please. The first meal at camp is dinner at 5 pm, Make sure your child has money to buy food,

2. **Security deposit.** We require a \$100 security deposit (in cash) which will be refunded to you at the end of your stay if no damage has been done to the premises. In case of small damage or special cleaning needed, the camp will keep the deposit and may contact the parents if a larger amount is needed.

3. **Collection of important belongings.** For everyone's peace of mind, we collect passports, money, medicine and any other important items to place them in the camp office. Campers will have access to their belongings at any time during camp and all belongings will be returned at the check-out.

4. **Medication.** We keep all types of medication out of the reach of campers. No campers are allowed to have any kind of medication in their rooms. Parents must submit medication and instructions for administration to our senior staff when checking in at camp and our staff will take care of administering such medication to your children as indicated.



CAMP CHECK-OUT

1. **Departures.** Sundays at 10 am. Airport transfers will be addressed individually depending on traveling times.

Note: If you need airport transportation please request it in the registration form and submit a completed Airport Transportation Request Form. If the plane departs late on Sunday after 10 am, make sure your children has some money to buy lunch and/or dinner.

2. **Returns.** Security deposits, passports, and all personal items will be returned at check-out.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

This is the checklist of suggested items for campers to bring to camp:

- Backpack, no suitcase please!
- Comfortable athletic and casual clothing.
- Hiking shoes, running shoes, and sandals.
- Rain coat.
- Hat and sunscreen to protect from the sun.
- Water bottle to carry all day to keep hydrated.
- Bathing suit and towel for showering and swimming in the lake.
- Insect repellent lotion.
- Sweat pants and a hoodie.
- Personal hygiene items (tooth brush/paste, soap, shampoo, etc).
- A headlamp and batteries.
- Hiking poles.
- A small day pack for daily activities.
- Musical instruments (optional). Ex. guitar, flute, harmonica.
- Note: the camp provides one pillow, a sleeping bag and a mattress per camper. You may want to bring extra pillows or your own sleeping bag if you want.

Important notes:

1. Campers must wear the camp t-shirt every day. They will get one t-shirt the first day of camp and you can purchase extras if needed.
2. Please put name tags on your children's gear and clothes, it's easier to recognize their belongings and it helps to reduce the risk of losing them.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

1. Computers, tablets and video games are prohibited at camp. Electronic readers, music players and photo cameras are allowed in certain times of the day. Cellphones are allowed only to call home.
2. All electronic devices will be taken away from the campers and stored in the camp's office for safety. Campers will have access to their electronics upon authorization of the staff. All electronics are returned to the camper at the end of the camp session.
3. Camp Ecolart is not responsible neither for loss nor for damage of electronic devices unless mishandled by our staff. Each camper is responsible of their own electronics. Please avoid bringing electronics as much as possible, camp is the best place to disconnect from the digital world and connect with real people and friendships.






COMMUNICATION WITH CAMPERS

For campers staying 2 weeks, we provide one load of laundry (washer, dryer and detergent). Laundry day is half way through the session. Campers won't have access to the laundry room any other day. Our staff helps campers to do their laundry, do not panic!
